you'll need a Young Worker  
Readiness Certificate of  
Completion before you  
can work.**

You can take the Young Worker Readiness Certificate Course online at [www.aeel.gov.sk.ca/youth-at-work](http://www.aeel.gov.sk.ca/youth-at-work).

Your employer will need to keep your certificate on file. You should also keep a copy of your original certificate at home.

Along with your certificate, you will also need to give your employer:

- proof of your age
- written consent of your parent or guardian
